PORDAMSA glassware is suitable for **ovens**, **microwaves**, **freezers and refrigerators**.

As glass is delicate, handle it with care. The glass **does not withstand extreme changes** in temperature and can cause it to crack. These changes must be made **gradually**.

For prolonged use, we recommend **washing the pieces by hand**. When using the dishwasher, **use short cycles and moderate temperatures (50-60°C)**. Avoid using abrasive or abrasive detergents or when rinsing by hand.

Do not heat directly over hot plates or any other direct source of heat.

When poaching in the **microwave**, avoid overcooking or poaching without water.

When using the **oven**, do not introduce the product all at once, especially if it is cold and the oven is already hot. We recommend that you put it back into the oven as soon as it is on. This way it will heat up progressively, preventing it from burning or burning.

Always inspect the piece before using it. Even new glassware can be damaged during transportation, and previously damaged containers can be broken or damaged during transport or packaging.

For delicate glass pieces, we recommend stacking them by placing a separator between the pieces for better protection. A cardboard separator can be used to separate them.

Due to the characteristics of the material and the manufacturing process, some glass items may contain small air bubbles and/or dots. However, they do not affect the quality of the product. In general, it is not very visible and, in fact, it contributes to the normal and attractive appearance of handmade glass. There are defined limits to acceptable irregularities, and these are part of our normal quality control.
